1 DISTRICT UPDATES

CPS DISTRICT UPDATES

- > CPS BOE passed proposal for the 2021-22 school year beginning a week earlier on August 30
- > In April, P-EBT cards will be loaded with distribution from January through March 2021
- > CPS recommends to the BOE to approve a modification to the promotion policy that will advance all elementary students to the next grade level in the fall and students with final failing grades in reading or math would be recommended to attend summer school.

ASSESSMENTS

- > ACCESS testing for EL students will continue
- > Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) will be administered in person to all 3rd-8th grade students
- > The CPS High School Admissions Test will be used to determine selection for choice & SEHS programs replacing NWEA & SEHS exam for SEHS applications for SY22


3 BUDGET REPORT
